If your total income is less than or equal to 400% below the Federal Poverty Income Limit Guidelines, you are qualified for 100% medication financial assistance coverage (medications are provided at no cost to patient).

²**FAP:** Assists with diagnostic lab and other medical bills. Please refer to the chart above to determine the estimated financial percentage assistance based on a sliding fee scale.
