Health Assistance Program (HAP): In addition to the Financial Assistance Program, the HAP helps eligible low- and middle-income families obtain prescription medications at no cost, even if they have insurance. [Free Access Health Clinic will assist you with the application process.](#)

If you qualify: All co-pays and costs are waived for both brand-name and generic prescriptions. For example, a family of four with a household income of \$100,000 could save up to \$600 per month on out-of-pocket costs at the pharmacy. Medications can be picked up at a UVM Health Network pharmacy or conveniently mailed to your home.

HAP also provides: (1) Access to eyeglasses and medical equipment. (2) Assistance with enrollment in state and federal programs, including obtaining insurance through the Vermont Health Connect exchange. (3) Advocacy and support with obtaining other health care related resources.
